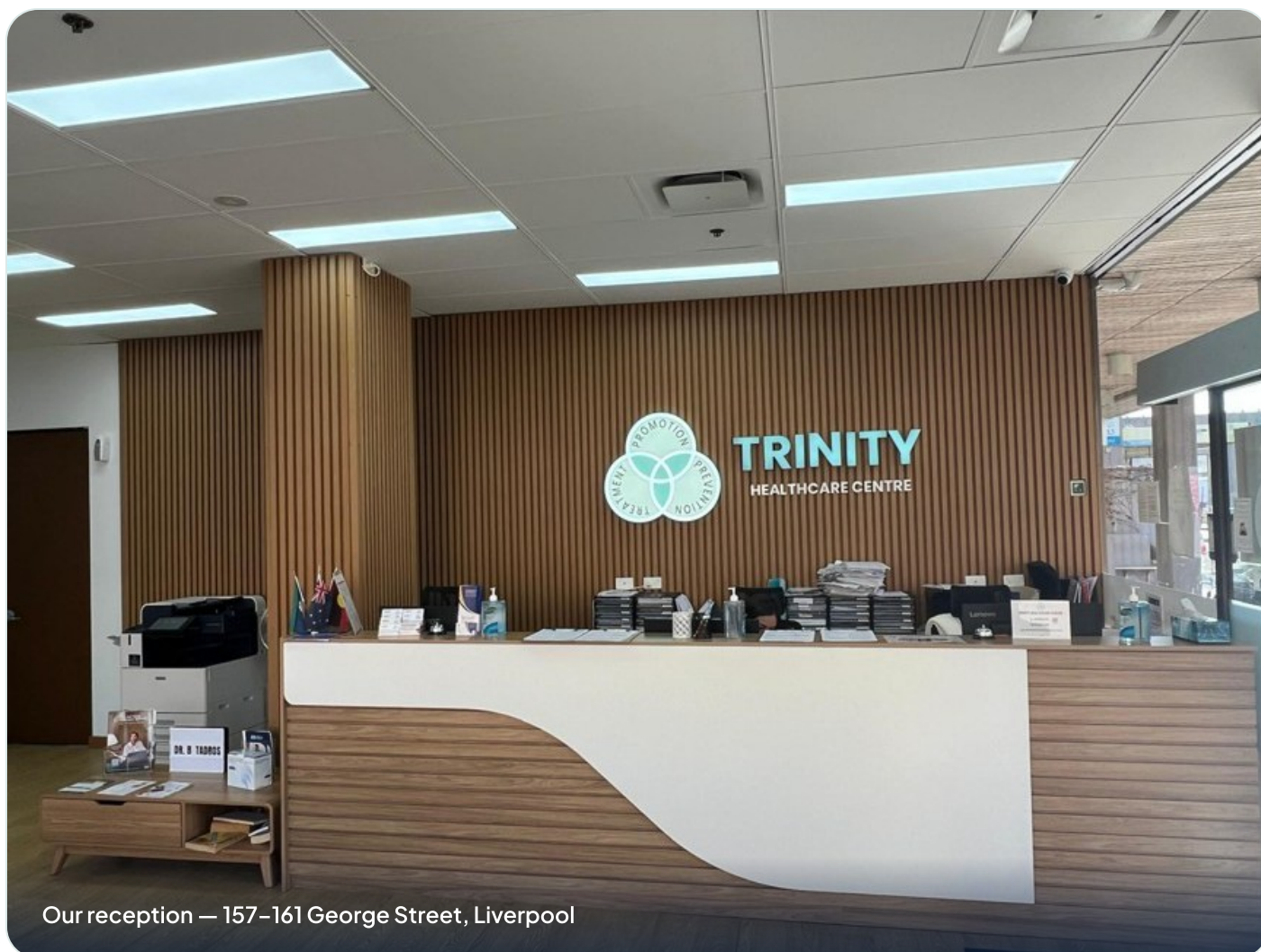
01 – Who we are

National Relay Service (NRS)

An Australian Government initiative offering call services for people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech impairment. Relay Officers help with every call and will:

- Change voice to text, or text to voice
- Change Auslan to English, or English to Auslan
- Stay on the line throughout the call without changing what is said

The NRS is **free** and **confidential**, available 24 hours a day. Video Relay calls operate 7am–6pm Mon–Fri and 8am–12pm Saturday (AEST).
